PARKING ON COLLEGE PROPERTY

It is the policy of the College that the parking of vehicles be regulated on property owned by the College.

Only personal vehicles belonging to occupants of the residence halls are allowed to be parked on campus for extended periods of time. All parked vehicles must be properly registered and in operable condition.

Individuals shall refrain from parking in restricted areas. These included the following:

- Where signs indicate “No Parking” or parking by special permit, i.e., “Handicapped”
- Sidewalk accesses
- On sidewalks or lawns
- Other restricted areas

The Board of Trustees authorizes the Administration to enter into lease agreements with local municipalities regarding lots.

The College may establish fees for parking on college property, subject to approval of the Board of Trustees.
